Language Therapy & Research

Each year, the **Child Language Research Lab at Purdue** offers a unique, no-cost program for children with language delays. The Summer Fun program combines language research with speech-language therapy for eligible 4- and 5-year-olds, at no cost to parents.

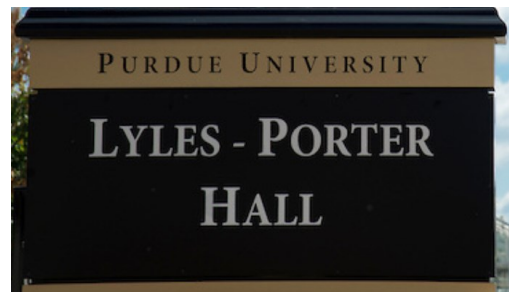
During Summer Fun, children participate in general preschool activities and a variety of fun and language-enriching experiences. Each child has individualized communication goals, which are addressed during daily half-hour therapy sessions, as well as in the classroom. Parents are provided with a written report and the opportunity to meet with clinical staff at the end of the program to discuss their child's progress.

Details: To participate, children must be between 4 and 5 years of age by June 1st and have a significant delay in language development without accompanying medical problems, hearing impairment or other developmental delays.

Dates: June 16th through July 9th

Days: Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings

Location: This will be the first year that Summer Fun is held in **Lyles-Porter Hall**.



Families are reimbursed \$9 per session for eligibility testing and
\$9 per day for participation in research.
