Purpose:

The Summer Intensive Articulation and Phonology Program is designed to provide intervention over the summer for children ages 4-8 years of age who receive speech and language therapy during the school year. By participating in the Summer Intensive groups, children can continue progress with goals and decrease the likelihood of regression over the summer.

Description:

The program is designed to help children learn and practice producing sounds accurately. The sounds targeted for improvement will be determined through speech evaluation, current speech goals from school, the Speech-Language Pathologist, and parent concerns.

Groups will have 2-3 children, to be determined based on age and skills to be addressed.



Schedule and Cost:

The Summer Intensive Articulation and Phonology Program runs for 6 weeks beginning the first week on Thursday, June 18th and ending on Thursday, July 30th. Each session will run for 90 minutes.

Children ages will meet 2 days per week: Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:30-12:00 for a total cost of: \$224.00.

Clinical Services:

Clinical services are provided by graduate student clinicians under the supervision of qualified clinical faculty and instructors who are licensed by the State of Indiana and certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association. Supervision will be provided by Clinical Assistant Professor Barb Cicholski, M.A., CCC-SLP and Clinical Associate Professor and Clinic Director Mary Lou Poole, M.S., CCC-SLP.

Location:

The Clinics are located in Lyles-Porter Hall at Purdue University. Our facilities are accessible to physically handicapped persons via first level entrance from the parking garage which is attached to the building. The clinic office and waiting room are on the first floor of Lyles-Porter Hall and are open from 8 a.m. -5 p.m.
