- _____ (4) To receive information about, and interview, prospective employees.
- _____ (5) With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction:
 - _____ (A) to receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and
 - _____ (B) to discuss, prior to any determination, that individual's status as an employee, student, or independent contractor who is a physician.
- _____ (6) For discussion of records classified as confidential by state or federal statute.
- _____ (7) To discuss before any placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performance, behavior, and needs.
- _____ (8) To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees.
- _____ (9) When considering the appointment of a public official, to:
 - _____ (A) develop a list of prospective appointees;
 - _____ (B) consider applications, and
 - _____ (C) make one (1) initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration.
